## Developing the website

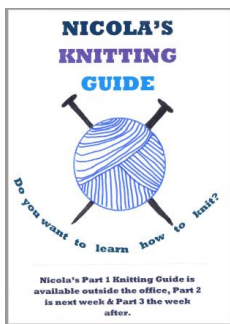
