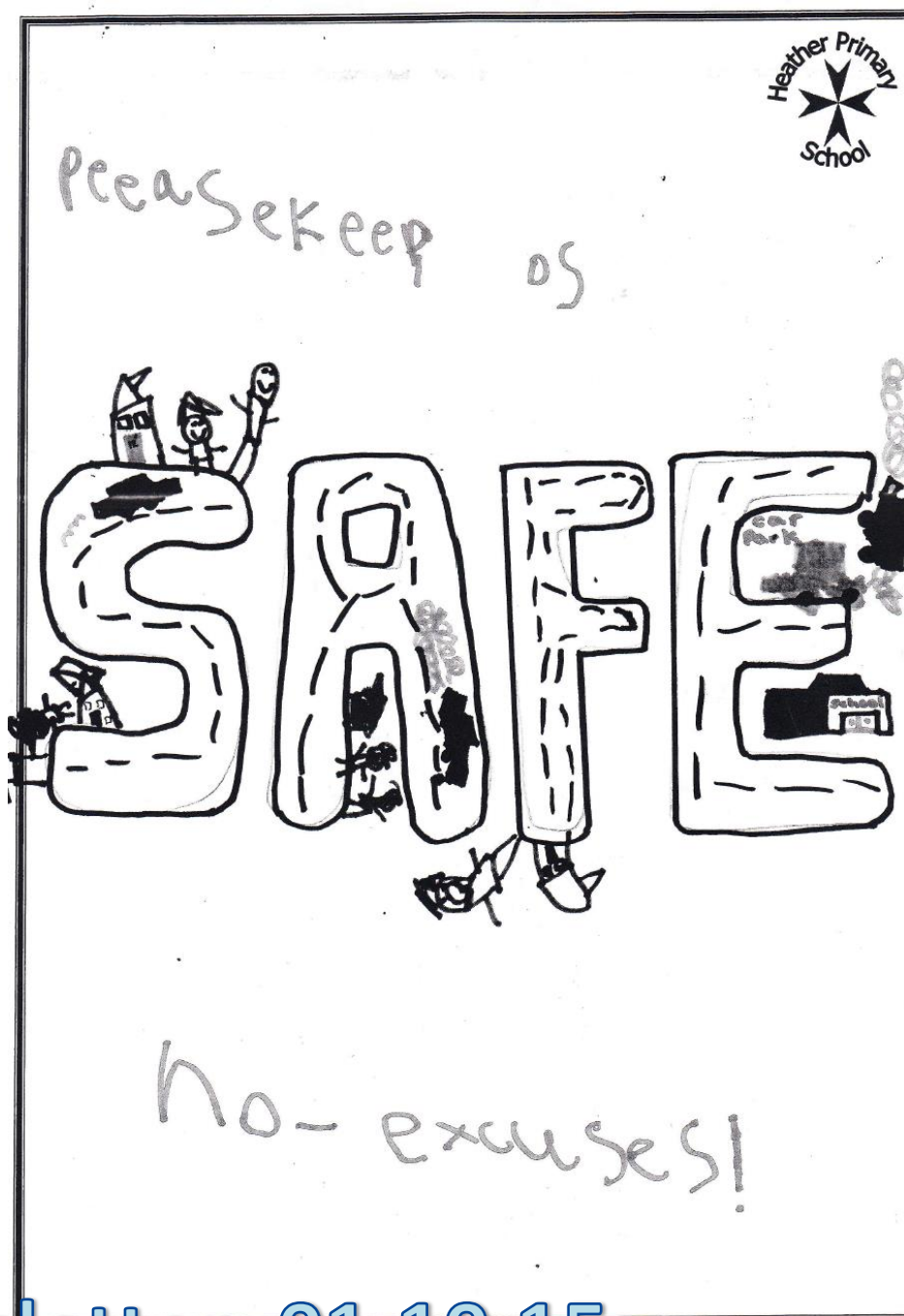


Heather Primary School
