In the assembly, he talked about his life and how he became an athlete. He is visually impaired, which means his eyes don't work as well as they should and he also suffers from arthritis. His Dad also had the same problems with his eyes. He has represented GB at Judo and was in the London 2012 Olympic Games. He told us he can do a back-flip and that his guide dog 'Elmo' can do one too! Dan's girlfriend is also a para-athlete and she has won medals in the Olympic Games. Dan has won lots of medals and is competing in Germany soon.
